The 2018/19 TY ICT curriculum is based on the completion of the ECDL (European Computer Driving License) and a set of on-line courses. (See Curriculum format below:)

In order to be considered for the BGS ICT Award, students must complete the ECDL certificate, complete 4 online courses decided by the school (outlined below) and then complete a fifth course that the student decides. The courses have been chosen to open doors with ICT as a career for the student.

Part A:

Complete the full ECDL certificate. (Accomplished by passing 7 different ECDL modules) You must gain 75% or more in order to pass an exam.
