Traffic Disruption

VMS boards on Clonakilty Road, Macroom Road, N71 and Dunmanway Road have been erected to advise HGVs to use Bypass Road. They also advise that works are ahead, and that Bandon is Open for Business.

Ahead of road closures advanced warnings will be given through signage and advertisement on AA Road Watch and local Radio Stations. These works will be carried out in phases in order to reduce impact to businesses and residents. Local access will be maintained at all times.
